## **PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE**

Hello Wayne Business Association,

First, let's touch on the incredible flooding on August 13th that has crushed area businesses and home owners. There is not much more to say except... start spending the money in the stormwater fee account! Let's make sure to support those businesses on West Avenue as they recover - Cornerstone, Real Pizza, 7 West Carpet, Renewal, Ivory Tree Portraits, and Main Line Print Shop. All these businesses and more sustained loss, and insurance doesn't recoup anything when it's a flood!!

The WBA Board and Radnor Township has commissioned an Impact Study of the WBOD. Town centers are being built all around us and it is becoming increasingly important to understand the value of an original town center. We all know as businesses that we pay taxes and would like the community to know we aren't asking for a handout in any way. The WBA has been working to improve Wayne's infrastructure over the past few years with Radnor Township and the BOC. Radnor Township has overseen all PECO repair work that has taken place over the past 2 years - the electrical service on N. Wayne Avenue and an upgraded gas main on N. Wayne, S. Wayne, and Conestoga Roads. With the gas project coming to an end, we look forward to street repaving, street scape renewal, cross walk repair, and additional trash cans throughout the WBOD. This all costs money. Investing in Wayne's WBOD is very important! Please read the study when it comes out... lots of interesting facts. It is amazing how much money and tax revenue is produced in our small town.

Speaking of improvements, the Radnor Conservancy is planning the purchase of 6 recycling cans to be placed in Wayne. Please recycle. That means don't throw your trash in the recycling containers, if you do, it all becomes trash.

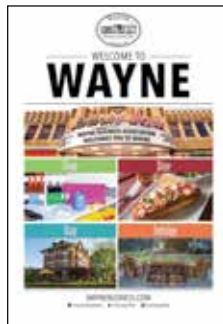
