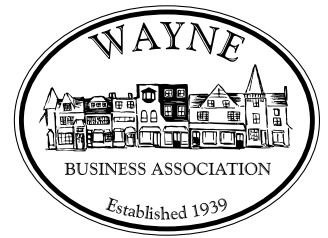

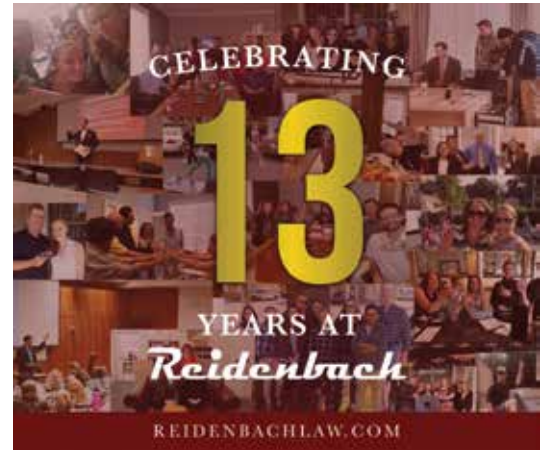

KEYSTONE MARKER RESTORATION

The two historic signs that welcome travelers to the town via Lancaster Avenue and South Wayne Avenue were temporarily removed in May for repainting and restoration. These types of historic signs, known as Keystone Markers, date back as far as the 1920s, and were installed all over Pennsylvania along state roads. The restoration work is being done by the Radnor Historical Society in conjunction with the Keystone Marker Trust, and is being sponsored by the Wayne Business Association. 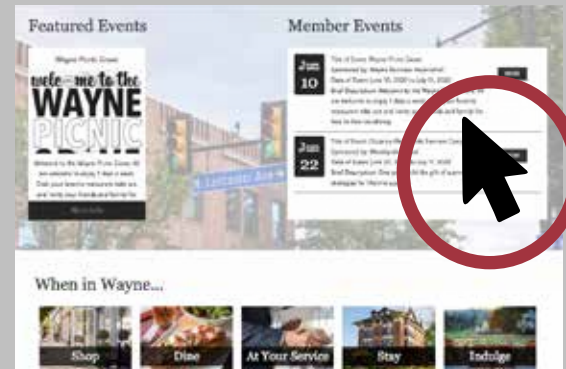
