STAY INFORMED

SOUTH WAYNE AVENUE FLOOD REDUCTION PROJECT CONSTRUCTION

The South Wayne Avenue Flood Reduction Project construction is underway. Please see the closures and restrictions below:

- The South Wayne Municipal Park Lot will be closed starting May 31, 2022, for the project duration through November of 2022.
- South Wayne Avenue will be closed from Runnymede Avenue to West Wayne Avenue,
 7:00 AM 4:00 PM, Monday through Saturday, starting June 17, 2022, through September of 2022
- School Lane will be closed from South Wayne Avenue for approximately 1,000 feet, 7:00 AM 4:00 PM, from August 1 through August 21 weekdays, (this time period will be updated as the project moves forward)
- West Wayne Avenue will be closed from South Wayne Avenue to past the Post Office, 7:00 AM 4:00 PM, from August 1 through August 21 weekdays (this time period will be updated as the project moves forward)
- Runnymede Avenue will be closed from South Wayne Avenue to the municipal parking lot entrance, 7:00 AM 4:00 PM, from September 12 through September 16 (this time period will be updated as the project moves forward)

Please note that there is overlap in the road closure scheduling; not all streets will be closed concurrently. The detour for South Wayne Avenue is Conestoga Road to Lancaster Avenue.



EAC PROPOSED PLASTIC BAG ORDINANCE RECEIVES PRELIMINARY APPROVAL

Radnor's Environmental Advisory Committee (EAC) brought forth an ordinance to regulate the use and distribution of single-use plastic bags. A majority of the Board of Commissioners voted to introduce this ordinance which will be *up for adoption in August*.



- Each retail establishment will be asked to provide signs by every check-out station informing customers that in six months, single-use plastic bags and non-recyclable paper bags will no longer be permitted
- After a six-month warning period, a store may not provide single-use plastic shopping bags or non-recyclable paper bags
- A retail establishment may provide recyclable paper bags but must charge a minimum of 10 cents per bag. This fee will be retained by the business to help defray the additional cost of paper bags as compared to plastic bags and to discourage customers from relying on paper bags
- Customers will be encouraged to bring or purchase reusable bags
- Exemptions to businesses who might suffer an undue hardship will be available





