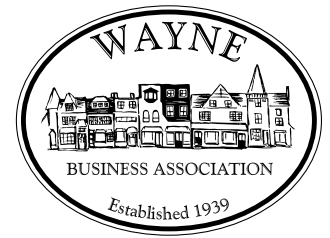

Radnor Township is transitioning from a Pay-by-Space to Pay-by-Plate parking system using the ParkMobile app starting on March 30, 2026, followed by parking kiosks during the week of April 13, 2026, allowing users to pay, extend sessions, and manage parking for the 900+ Township spaces via smartphone or at a kiosk.



Say goodbye to "Pay-by-Space." Whether you use the ParkMobile app or a Kiosk, all you need is your license plate number!

- App Users: Enter your plate + zone number.
- Kiosk Users: Simply enter your plate number at the machine.

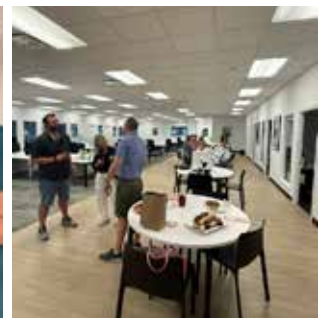

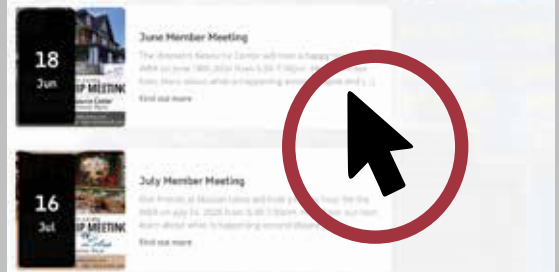
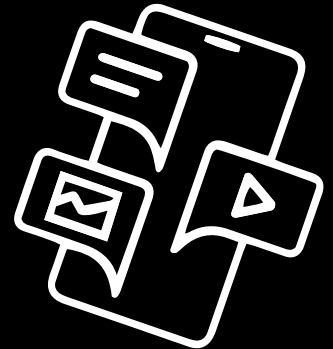
